Recruitment Overview

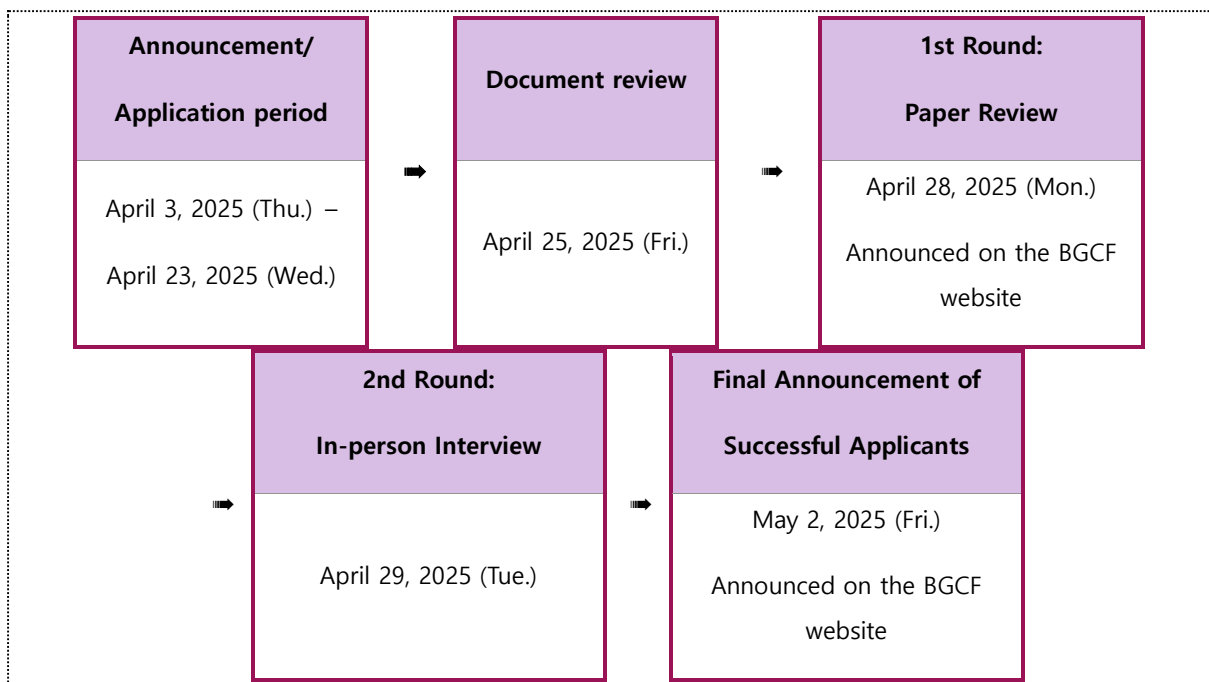
- Recruitment Period : April. 3. 2025(Thu.) ~ April. 23. 2025(Wed.)
- Target : Any foreign resident of Busan over the age of 18
 - ※ Long-term visa holders for more than 90 days
- Number of Participants : Approximately 20 people
- Eligibility for application
 - ※ In accordance with the Immigration Control Act of the Republic of Korea, only those who have completed foreigner registration and can communicate smoothly in Korean
 - As of the day before the announcement date, foreign residents who have lived in Korea for over a year, including workers, married immigrants, international students, and Korean compatriots aged 18 or older and have

lived in Busan for over 90 days.

- Any foreign resident of Busan who is passionate about promoting Busan
- Who wants to make Busan a global city where foreigners can live
- Those who are interested in community activities and enjoy diverse cultures and communication

□ Selection process and screening/selection of candidates

Process	Recruitment Announcement → Paper Review → Interview → Results Announcement
Screening and Selection	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ① Paper Review: Overall Screening of qualification, application and attachments, contents of the application, Korean Proficiency, preferences, and experience of activities ② Interview: Selecting qualified applicants including capability, experience, nationality, and visa type- through a judging committee.

○ **Preference** (will be given to applicants who meet one or more of the following)

- Individuals with experience participating in foreign resident-related projects organized by Busan City (e.g., Foreign Residents' Representative Association, etc.)
- Active users of social media or online platforms with strong communication skills
- Those with skills in video production and editing who can contribute to promotional content
- Applicants with strong document writing and computer skills
- Proficient in Korean (intermediate level or higher)
- Individuals with prior experience in community activities, or award history in related fields

○ **Disqualification**

- ※ The selection may be cancelled if a criminal history is discovered or committed during the selection or activity period
- Those who family court has judged the commencement of adult guardianship due to a lack of ability based on mental restrictions caused by illness, disability, old age, etc.
- Those sentenced to imprisonment and execution has terminated or two years have not elapsed from the date of exemption from execution
- Those sentenced to suspended imprisonment and in the grace period
- Those with two years of a sentence which still needs to be served.

□ **Main Roles**

- Provide useful local lifestyle information for foreign residents (district-based missions, carried out regularly)
- Identify challenges faced by foreign residents and propose relevant policies
- Strengthen community cohesion through participation in local activities
- Promote communication and visibility both online and offline

Benefits

- Stipend provided for participation
- Certificate of participation issued upon completion
- Awards presented to outstanding connectors at the end of the year
- Official activity articles published and promoted on the 'Life in Busan' platform
- Volunteer hours recognized via 1365 system for external activities
- Invitations to Busan Global City Foundation-hosted events
- Opportunities for media interviews and promotions

Important Notes

- ※ Exceptions may be considered under special circumstances following prior discussion.
- Applicants may be disqualified from participation under the following conditions
 - False information found in the application or submitted documents
 - Repeated absences or lack of sincerity during program activities
 - Failure to respond or attend mandatory events such as the orientation and appointment ceremony
 - Any other cases in which participation is deemed difficult by the organizers

Additional Information

- Selected representatives must attend the award ceremony and orientation held in May
- Submitted documents will not be returned. The applicant is responsible for any disadvantages caused by errors in the application or failure to submit required documents.
- If there are no suitable candidates, the number of final participants may be adjusted.
