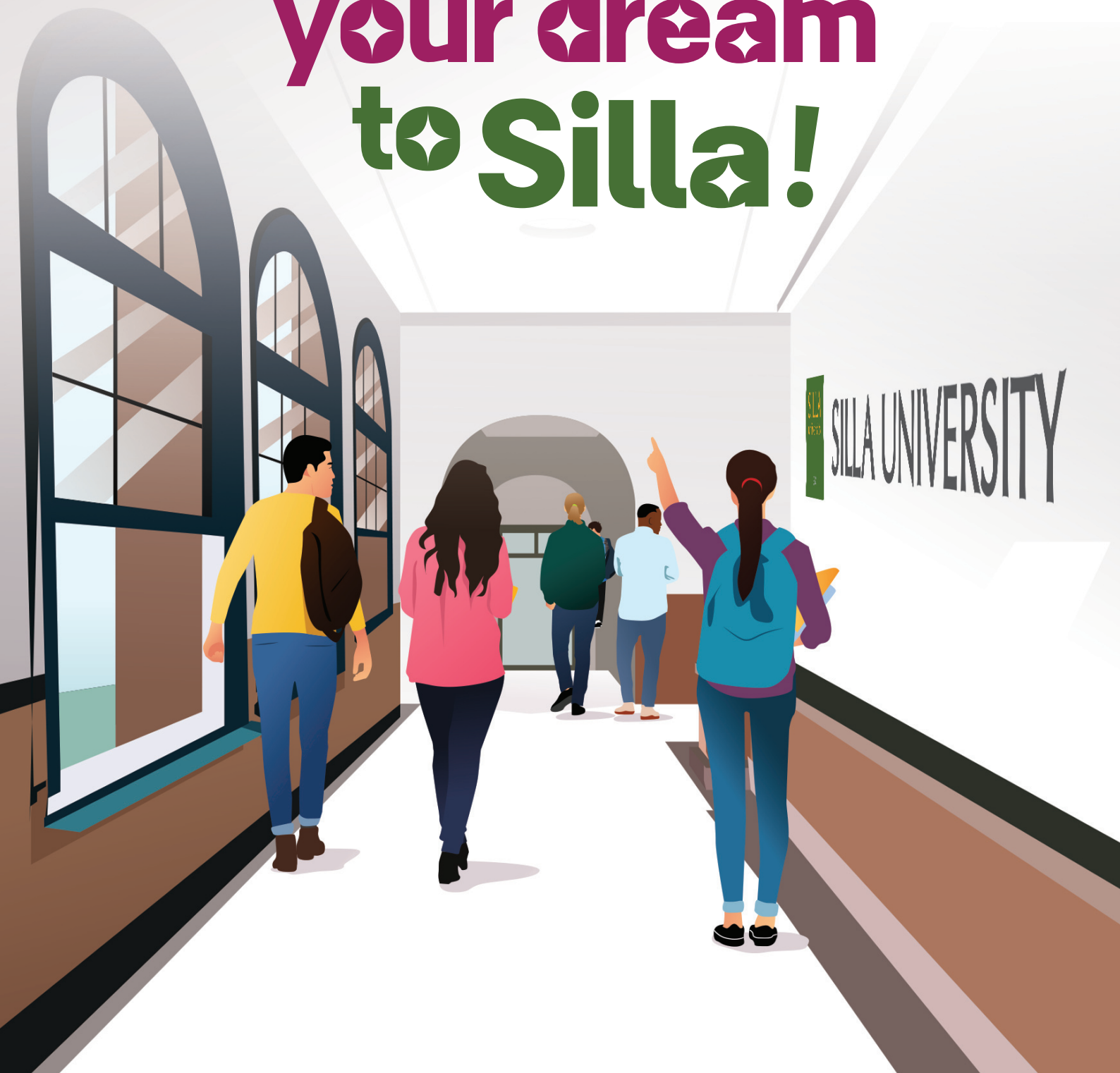

– Foreign nationals who stay in Korea for an extended period are generally required to enroll in the National Health Insurance (NHI) system. Those who hold a residence visa and stay for more than six months are automatically registered, unless they are covered by an equivalent private or overseas insurance.

The NHI provides access to affordable healthcare services, including hospital visits, medical treatments, and prescription medications. Once enrolled, foreign residents can receive the same level of medical benefits as Korean citizens, making it easier to access quality healthcare during their stay in Korea.

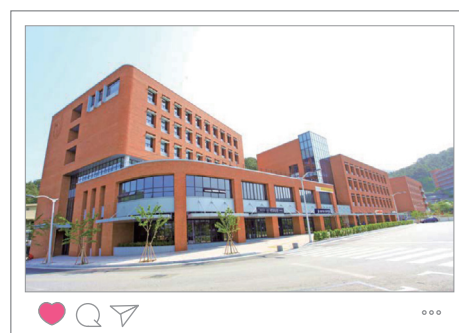

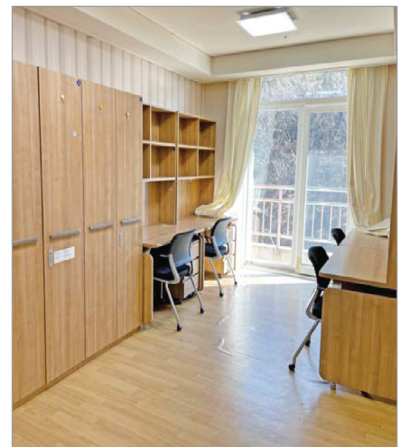

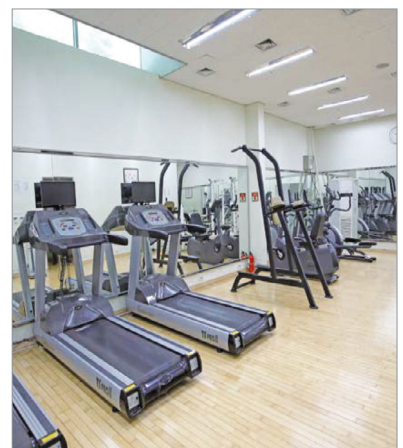
