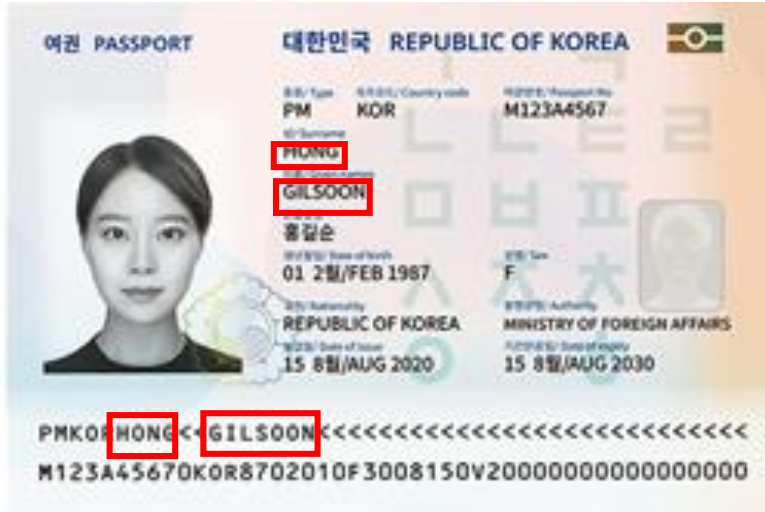

[Must Read] Important Notes

1. The applicant's English name, date of birth in the application form should match with what is written on the applicant's passport.



Example: Hong Gilsoon

2. It is not allowed to change department or major after admission application.
3. All submitted documents can not be returned. So if it is hard to re-issue the original document, do not submit the original copy, but submit a notarization or verification of the original.
4. You have to prepare the visa issuance' documents for Korea embassy apart from the admission documents in advance.
5. If all application documents won't be attached within the deadline or the documents are insufficient at online, the applicants will be disqualified without notice. **Accidents or unexpected events occurring throughout the attachment process do not constitute reasons for deadline extension.**
6. Applicant should write their personal information accurately and all notifications will be updated on the website of International Affairs, Dong-A University.
7. **Applicant should read this guideline and notes carefully and follow the procedure made by Dong-A University.**

A. Nationality Standard: Applicant and both parents must be non-Korean citizens.

※ Application is restricted to the students with dual nationality or stateless person.

- ※ For both types, students are not required to write a thesis and admission fee for doctoral program will be exempted.

- ※ In the case of TOEFL iBT, applicants who took the test by **January 20, 2026** must have a **score of 71 or higher (revised score 4 or above)**.
- ※ Applicants who apply for departments in the College of Natural Science and Engineering whose medium of instruction is "**Korean / English**" can submit English proficiency test score of English track and can be awarded English proficiency test score scholarship.
- ※ **The certificate of language proficiency test is only recognized for the test taken within 2 years from application deadline .(Tests taken after 2024.6.21. are acceptable.)**

[Applicants exempt for the above language requirements]

- ① **Applicants for Natural Sciences / Engineering / Sports & Art (Except Applied Bioscience department)**
- ② Applicants who have completed high school education in countries* where their mother tongue language is English are exempt from the above language requirements.
- * South Africa, New Zealand, USA, Ireland, UK, Canada, Australia

※ Even if English is the first language of education at the previous high school or university located in the countries* not in the list above, 'English proficiency certificate' issued by the relevant institution is not acceptable.

4. Evaluation Method

A. How to evaluate: **[Comprehensive evaluation(100%)] Document screening(40%)+Interview(60%)**

B. Evaluation factor

- Document screening: based on the submitted documents
(Academic records, Career related to applied major, research performance)
- Interview: comprehensive evaluation (Education background, attitude)
- ※ All applicants must participate in the interview and those who are unable to attend the interview in Korea can participate in the interview by telecommunication(video call, cellular phone, E-mail, etc.)
- ※ Those who apply for the department of Arts or Sports can be asked for a performance assessment if necessary.
- ※ Reasons for disqualification will not be disclosed.

5. Admission Unit

A. **Korean Track:** It offers courses conducted entirely(or partially) in Korean. Only applicants who have Korean proficiency can apply for this program.

However, departments in the College of Natural Science and the College of Engineering with (*) mark may offer some courses in English and applicants can get admission and scholarships with English proficiency test certificate.

B. **English Track:** It offers courses conducted in English. Only applicants who have English proficiency can apply for this program.

- ※ There is no special majors in master's course and detailed major could be changed according to the circumstances of the department.

7. Notes of Document submission

- A. After the application is completed (payment of the application fee), it is not acceptable to change the application details, such as changing majors or submitting additional documents.
- B. All submitted documents must be attached to the online application site within application period, and **it will be disqualified if required documents are not attached or it's unidentifiable to check**.
- C. All required documents to be submitted must be **in Korean or English**. **Documents in any other languages must have a notarized translation into Korean or English and attached.**
- D. Additional documents may be requested as necessary. The document deemed necessary for application procedure may increase or decrease according to the decision of the Office of International Affairs, Dong-A university.
- E. **Personal statement and study plan should be written in Korean or English.** If it is found to be false or to be written by others, the application will be disqualified.
- F. **Certificate of (expected) Graduation (Applicants should submit one of the following documents.)**
- 1) Members of the Apostille Convention: Submit Apostille Certification**
- 2) Non-Member of the Apostille Convention: Submit Verification by the Korean Consulate**
 ※ Verification and apostille should be acquired in the country where applicants' schools are located.
- 3) Graduate of Chinese institution : Submit both ① AND ②**
- ① The verification at the website of China Higher Education Student Information(English version).

- ② Copy of a Graduation certificate and Degree(**It should be translated and notarized in Korean or English**, If your school issue only one of them, you cannot apply for the admission)
- ※ We require a Education Verification consent letter allowing Dong-A University to conduct Education verifications of the applicant. If an applicant does not cooperate with education verification or Dong-A University does not receive any verification, the admission can be cancelled even after a successful admission.

G. Regarding Transcript

- Official academic transcript from graduated institution should be issued in [Korean or English]. If not, it should be translated and notarized in [Korean or English] and attach the original copy additionally.
- **Percentile of academic scores or CGPA with full scale must be shown on the transcript.**
- ※ If it is not shown on the transcript, applicant should submit an official letter including those information from the graduated institution.
- ※ If it is not available to receive an official letter from the graduated institution, original transcripts with converted scores from WES(World Education Services, <http://www.wes.org>) will be accepted for C.G.P.A. calculation.

H. Certificate of family relationship

- Documents indicating the relationship and nationality of the applicant and the applicant's parents(translated and notarized) such as Birth certificate, Family card and so on.
- ※ Issued by applicant's home country government(original copy and translated in Korean or English)
- ※ In case that one or both parents are missing in the certificate, please submit related documents such as certificate of divorce or death.
- ※ In the case of a single-parent family, submit the Status Confirmation of Single-parent Family (Form 8 attached) with official verification from the government of your country.

I. Financial Supporting Documents(Bank balance statement): 16,000,000 KRW or above

(Approx. 12,100 USD/Based on 1USD=1,330KRW, the currency can be different)

- Applicant residing in Korea should submit a Korean bank statement.
- Applicant from Dong-A University students in Degree & Korean Language Course can submit 8,000,000 KRW or above
- Documents must be issued within 1 months depends on the admission' application date
- When the financial guarantor submits the document, combine ① Proof of financial guarantor's income and ② Employment certificate ③ Certificate of Finance support(form4) in 1 file and submit.
- The number of guaranteed international students per advisor is limited to 1 student (Ministry of Justice guidelines)
- Applicant can be asked for additional documents depending on his/her nationality.
- It is necessary to deposit the designated amount of money in consideration of the visa application period and the time of entry depends on the Korean embassy announcement.
- ✓ **Uzbekistan:** 'KDB bank' balance certificate deposited for **at least one month** (more than USD 13,000)
- ✓ **Vietnam:** Certificate of bank balance deposited for **at least 3 months** (more than 16,000,000KRW)
- ※ Please check the notes in advance on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Korea.

J. The name and date of birth on the application form has to be identical with the passport.

K. If document submission in online is not possible, submission by mail or in person is possible only for reasons that can be officially confirmed (communication cut-off, natural disaster, etc.)

8. Notes after Admission

A. Original Documents (hard copy) Submission

- Applicant who passed the admission is required to submit all hardcopy documents to the office of International Affairs, Dong-A University within the designated period
- **Original Documents (hardcopy) Submission deadline: By 2026.7.31.(Fri)**
- ※ Those who do not submit hard copies within the designated period will be disqualified and admission will be cancelled.

9. Important Notes

- A. **Applicants should read this guidelines carefully and follow the procedure made by Dong-A University.** When applicants do not comply with the university's prescribed process and rules, or required documents are not completely submitted, the applicants will be disqualified. The applicants are responsible for disadvantages (cancellation of application, revocation of admission, etc.) as a result of missing documents, errors or omissions, or any uncompleted entry procedures. Details on the evaluation and admission decisions will not be released.
- B. **It is not allowed to change department or major** and you cannot cancel your admission application after the completion of admission application.
- C. Failure to submit all or part of required documents can result in the cancellation of admission without interview even though the applicant completes an online application and pays an application fee.
- D. If an admitted applicant fails to complete tuition payment during the designated period, admission will be revoked.
- E. **If a applicant is accepted to two or more universities, he or she must select one university for registration.** Simultaneous registration at more than one university may result in revocation of admission to Dong-A university.
- F. Even if a applicant is eligible for application, there is a possibility for Dong-A university not to select him/her to be a successful candidate in case Dong-A university decides s/he is not enough to study in the university.
- G. **All announcement will be updated on the website of International Affairs. But, emergency contacts can be made mostly by Mobile and E-mail. Please write down your personal information correctly so that university can contact the applicant during the admissions period. The applicant is responsible for disadvantages as a result of incorrect contacts or being out of contact.**
- H. **In the following cases, we can cancel your acceptance or admission even after enrollment. If this cases is applicable, your academic records will be removed and the paid tuition will not be refunded.** Also, if our university or another university cancels your admission or registration due to those reasons, you will not be able to apply to our university for three years from the date of cancellation. The applicant may have civil and criminal liability in those cases.
- If you interrupted fair student selection by applying for the admission fraudulently such as a proxy interview or supporting others to do so.
 - Before, during and after the admission procedures, **if there is any problem with the documents' authenticity, eligibility, exam cheating, etc.**
- I. Matters not specified here will be decided under the policy of Dong-A university .
- J. If applicants cannot get a D-2 visa for study, Dong-A university can cancel the admission.
- K. Freshmen cannot take a leave of absence before or during the first semester.
- ※ **Dong-A University has a right and responsibility on the international graduate admission and is not responsible for any other information from the agency or any 3rd party.**
